

UPSSSC Syllabus 2022 (Lekhpal)

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1. General Hindi

Conjunctions, synonyms, antonyms, tatsams and tadbhavas, conjunctions, one word formation for phrases, proverbs and idioms, sentence modification, gender, word, factor, tense, spelling, error related, multiple words, questions based on unread passage

2. Mathematics

Arithmetic & Statistics

Number System, Percentage, Profit and Loss, Classification of Statistical Data, Frequency, Frequency Distribution, Tabulation, Cumulative Frequency. Data representation, bar chart, pie chart, histogram, frequency polygon. Central measure, arithmetic mean, median and mode

Algebra

Minimum Equilibrium and Maximum Equilibrium and their Relationships, Simultaneous Equations, Quadratic Equations, Multiplication Sections, Area Theorems

Geometry

Pythagoras theorem of triangle, perimeter and area of triangle, rectangle, square, trapezium, parallelogram, rhombus, circumference and area of circle

3. General Knowledge

General science, current events of national and international importance, history of India, Indian national movement, Indian polity and economy, world geography and population, questions of general science, general knowledge and knowledge of science including topics related to daily experience and observation, Which can be expected from any well educated person who has not studied any scientific subject. Under the history of India, attention will have to be paid to the comprehensive knowledge of economic, social, cultural and political aspects. On Indian National Movement, candidates are expected to have general knowledge about the nature and characteristics of Indian independence movement, the emergence of nationalism and attainment of independence. Indian polity under Indian polity and economy, Indian Constitution, There will be questions on knowledge of the broad features of India's economy and planning. Only general knowledge of subjects in world geography and population will be tested, in which special emphasis will be given on physical/ecological, economic, social, demographic aspects of geography of India. General information about the above is expected from the candidates, especially in the context of Uttar Pradesh. There will be questions related to the basic knowledge of computer

4. Rural Society and Development

Rural Development in the Indian context, Rural Development Programmes, Rural Development Plans and Management, Rural Development Research Systems, Rural Health Plans, Rural Social Development, Rural Development and Land Reforms, Three Tier Panchayati Raj System, Schemes related to Rural Development of Central and State Governments
