UKSSSC Syllabus 2022

It is mandatory for the general and OBC category candidates to get 45 percent and for the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe category candidates to get 35 percent marks, otherwise they will be considered disqualified in the written examination

In the written test question paper evaluation, 1 mark will be given for every correct answer and 1/4th negative mark will be given for every wrong answer

Candidates will be allowed to carry the question booklet of the written examination with them after the examination

OMR Answer Sheet of the written examination will be in triplicate. The second copy of the OMR answer sheet will be preserved separately and the third copy will be allowed to be carried by the candidate. Every candidate will compulsorily submit the original copy of the answer sheet and the second copy to the invigilator. Failure to do so will result in nullity of the candidate concerned. If the examination was conducted online, the candidates would be given their examination material through online mode

Penalty for Wrong Answers- Penalty (Negative Assessment) will be given for wrong answers given by the candidates in objective type question papers

Each question has four option answers. One-fourth of the marks assigned to the question will be deducted as penalty for each wrong answer given by the candidate

if a candidate gives more than one answer to any question, it will be treated as a wrong answer; Even if one of the given answers is correct, the same punishment will be given for that question as above

If a question is not attempted by the candidate, that is, no answer is given by the candidate, then no negative marks will be awarded for that question

Use of whitener or scouring/tampering of substitutes in OMR sheet is prohibited and negative marking will be given for this also

Candidates should submit their O.M.R. Wrong Roll No. in the sheet. Or marks the booklet series or does not mark anything, then its OMR. The sheet will not be evaluated and the candidature of the candidate will automatically be treated as cancelled

In the online examinations, this process will be done accordingly
