

## **Telangana High Court Syllabus 2022**

### **(Junior Assistant)**

#### **Stenographer**

1. The online computer based examination will be of the standard consistent with the minimum educational qualification prescribed i.e., graduation qualification. The question paper of the computer based examination shall be objective type with multiple choice answers for 50 marks. The Skill Test (Stenography) is for 30 marks and viva-voce will be for 20 marks.
2. The computer based examination will be conducted for 50 questions (25 questions – General Knowledge and 25 questions – General English) and each question will carry one (01) mark. The duration of the online examination will be 60 minutes.

#### **Copyist**

1. The online computer based examination will be of the standard consistent with the minimum educational qualification prescribed i.e., Intermediate qualification. The question paper of the computer based examination shall be objective type with multiple choice answers for 50 marks. The skill/typing test is for 30 marks and viva-voce will be for 20 marks.
2. The computer based examination will be conducted for 50 questions (25 questions – General Knowledge and 25 questions – General English) and each question will carry one (01) mark. The duration of the online examination will be 60 minutes.
3. For the computer based examination in respect of General Knowledge subject, the question paper will be made available in English and Telugu languages.

## **Examiner**

1. The online computer based examination will be of the standard consistent with the minimum educational qualification prescribed i.e., Intermediate qualification. The question paper of the computer based examination shall be objective type with multiple choice answers for 80 marks and viva-voce will be for 20 marks.
